Residential Living Dining & Grocery Guide

Thanks to all who are staying on campus and using the new Dining & Grocery Guide to plan your meals. This first week of receiving orders for both the LH Pantry and Oregon Dairy specialty items, had some challenges. We appreciate your patience as we work through how to best deliver this new service.

The Guide for next week (in mailboxes yesterday) has some changes we believe will help the process:

- Oregon Dairy orders for up to 10 specialty items will be received on Mondays from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. only. Tuesday delivery remains the same.
- LH Pantry orders will be received Wednesdays from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. only. Thursday delivery remains the same.

Also note that some items have been added, like butter and additional frozen meals.

Wearing Masks in the General Store

With the Governor's call for all people in public to wear facemasks, it is now required that anyone visiting or working in the General Store wear a face covering. There are masks for sale in the General Store that Landis Homes has purchased from outside vendors. Masks made and donated to Landis Homes are being used for Personal Care and Healthcare Residents as well as team members who do not provide direct care. You may wear a scarf or other fabric face covering if you do not wish to purchase a mask. Note: not all masks have the same structure

and design. Some masks are made to add filters as an attempt to make cloth masks more like medical grade masks. For persons not in healthcare, a fabric face covering is adequate.

Admissions to Residential Living

At this time, move-ins to campus have been suspended to any residence not accessible from a first floor, outside entrance. If someone wishes to transfer from one area of campus to another and can do so by moving their belongings in without accessing the interior of a building, it is permitted. New residents wishing to move to campus cottages or first floor dwellings accessible through a patio may do so given that they agree to self-isolate for 14 days once they arrive.

End of Life Visitors

We had previously shared that visits could no longer take place at end of life. Department of Health has provided clarification on this guideline. Landis Homes will now allow two visitors per day to visit residents at end of life. These individuals will be screened and required to wear facemasks. The health care provider and the Landis Homes care team will determine if a resident is considered to be near end of life.
