### Residential Living Reopening Plan

A document was placed in resident mailboxes this morning. This five-phase plan is designed to offer hope to let residents know changes are coming and to guide the team as we unwind many of the new systems that have been put in place. Thanks to all the team members who put time and energy into the thought process for this plan.

Because this framework for reopening the Landis Homes campus is based on designations made by the State of Pennsylvania, the start date and length of each phase is not known. It is important to note that as we enter each phase, we will begin to transition to the programs and services listed, but it will not take place immediately. WLH and published updates will provide more information as we go along. If COVID-19 is identified on campus, we will likely revert back to a previous phase. The statement "Follow Guidelines from CDC" refers to protocols for things like hand hygiene, wearing face coverings and maintaining social distancing.

**Today we are beginning the transition to the ORANGE Phase.** The most immediate change you will see is the reduced hours at the checkpoint. Dining and Life Enrichment will share announcements as they start new offerings, probably next week.



This document will be updated as more information becomes available. Please remain aware of the current phase of the plan through written documents, videos and campus signage.

**Healthcare and Personal Care** must adhere to Department of Health regulations and therefore are not following this five-phase plan.
