

Landis Homes Update

May 18, 2020

We continue to be without a known case of COVID-19 on the Landis Homes campus. No resident tests are pending at this time.

Residential Living Reopening Plan

On Friday, all Residential Living Households received the five-phase reopening plan for Landis Homes. We know it contains a great deal of information so we will continue to communicate key points of the plan as we move through the phases.

It is important to note that Landis Homes remains committed to following all guidelines from the CDC, CMS and the State of Pennsylvania. Our primary goal is to continue to keep residents and team members safe and healthy.

We are in the Orange Phase. As this transition to Orange occurs, we are only adjusting to include things that are allowed under the Pennsylvania Red Phase designation. The following programs and services listed on the plan in the column for the Orange Phase are important for you to be aware of at this time:

- **Checkpoint** – Hours modified to 5:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. Doors remained locked as in Red Phase
- **Dining** – Order and delivery service unchanged. The option for take-out orders from the Owl Hill Bistro begins this Wednesday, May 20. Orders are still to be placed by phone.
- **Groceries** – All grocery services remain. The list of items available from the RL Pantry will be reduced over time.
- **Laundry/Housekeeping** – Limited services available from the Landis Homes Team.
- **Maintenance** – Limited work within accommodations by Landis Homes Team.
- **Life Enrichment/Wellness** – Broadcasts continue. Low intensity classes led by team members will be scheduled outdoors beginning this Thursday, May 21. Registration is required and there is a limit of 10 per class. Participants will be screened and masks will be worn. Watch WLH for class details.

Everything noted above will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines from CDC, including hand hygiene, wearing face coverings and maintaining social distancing. As a reminder, if COVID-19 is identified on campus, we will likely revert back to a previous phase.

Healthcare and Personal Care must adhere to Department of Health regulations and therefore are not following the five-phase Residential Living Reopening Plan.



Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

We received another shipment of masks last week so we now have a good supply. An order of 1350 gowns should arrive Wednesday. Additional gowns are scheduled for delivery before the end of the month.

Reporting to Healthcare Residents, Resident Representatives and Families

CMS has added reporting requirements regarding Healthcare residents at Landis Homes. Though we have not had any COVID cases in Healthcare to date, beginning today, May 18, 2020, Landis Homes will notify healthcare residents, resident representatives and families by 5:00 p.m. the next calendar day of either;

- A single confirmed case of COVID-19 or
- Three or more residents or staff with new-onset of respiratory symptoms within 72 hours of each other (cluster)

Healthcare Residents will receive this information in writing. It will also be posted on the Landis Homes website for resident representatives and families. Notification will not include personally identifiable information. It will provide information on mitigation actions to prevent or reduce the risk of transmission. A weekly cumulative report will also be posted each Monday in accordance with the regulation. This is for cases in Healthcare only. We are making everyone aware because it will be posted on the Landis Homes website. We will continue to use this update to make you aware of cases anywhere on campus.
