

Landis Homes Update May 29, 2020

Today we are sharing more about COVID-19 testing – current tests, testing to date and universal testing in the Healthcare Center that will begin next week.

Current Positive Cases and Pending Tests

The team member who tested positive on May 23 remains self-quarantined at home. Yesterday, May 28, 2020, we learned of a second team member with a positive test result. This Healthcare team member last worked on May 20, 2020 and was not experiencing symptoms at the time. S/he believes the exposure came from a family member. The Department of Health has been notified and their investigation of the case indicates that the risk of transmission to others is low.

To protect individual privacy, team members or residents who test positive will not have their names, job titles, working locations or resident location shared broadly. Any other team member and/or resident who, through investigation or contact tracing, is identified to have had prolonged exposure will be contacted directly by a representative of Landis Homes or the Department of Health. Those team members and/or residents will be given instruction for self-quarantining and will be monitored by a Landis Homes representative. The Resident Activity Log will be utilized as previously described should a Residential Living resident test positive.

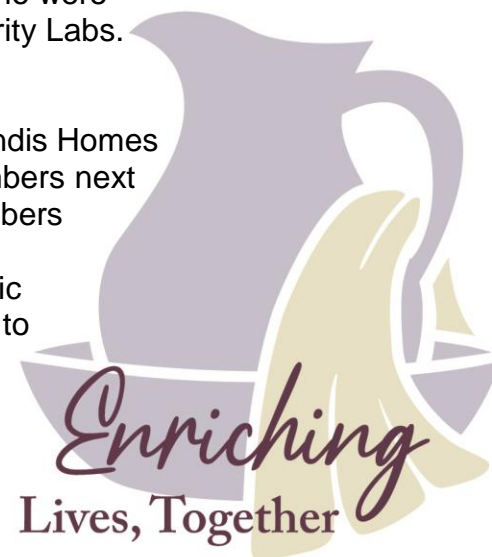
Two resident tests are pending, one in Personal Care from earlier in the week and we are aware of one new test for a resident in Healthcare.

Testing to Date

Since the start of the pandemic, we have been notified of 25 Landis Homes residents being tested for COVID-19 (22 negative, 1 positive, 2 pending) and 29 team members (24 negative, 2 positive, 3 pending). We are not aware of any tests for antibodies. Landis Homes had utilized the Department of Health and other labs to process early tests for Healthcare and Personal Care residents who were experiencing symptoms. We are now contracting directly with Clarity Labs.

Universal Testing

In accordance with guidelines from the State of Pennsylvania, Landis Homes will begin universal testing of Healthcare residents and team members next week. Testing will be conducted for both residents and team members simultaneously to provide the most accurate picture. The goal of universal testing is to rapidly detect asymptomatic/pre-symptomatic positive residents in order to manage their care appropriately and to



identify asymptomatic/pre-symptomatic team members so they can be excluded from work as needed to prevent transmission. A Resident FAQ for Universal Testing is being posted on the Landis Homes website later today if you would like additional information.

Updates & Reminders

- **Orange Phase** – The Landis Homes campus is currently in the Orange phase of the Residential Living reopening Plan. This coincides with the State of Pennsylvania Red phase and the Stay at Home order issued by Governor Wolf. Only essential visitors are able to be on campus at this time. We anticipate we will move to the Yellow Phase on June 5th, unless we see a rise in the number of positive cases on campus. The update on Monday will share information to help everyone prepare for the transition to Yellow.
