
### **Mother's Day**

### **Opening Campus**

Lancaster County remains in the "Red" phase of a three-phase effort to open the state. Yesterday Governor Wolf extended the Stay at Home order for red counties through June 4. We know this is difficult to hear, especially as the weather gets warmer and we want to enjoy time with family and friends. Please continue to adhere to the state guidelines and although all of Landis Homes is your home, we continue to discourage gathering together on campus for meals or social activities. **Contractors On Campus**

As we announced last week, contractors may be seen on campus preparing homes for new move-ins. Our policy is that these workers will be screened daily and will wear facemasks. There will be no more than two workers in any given space and they will be in residential areas as little as possible.
