

Landis Homes Update June 26, 2020

Lancaster County is moving to the Green Phase of reopening today. In our minds, Green means GO, but in this case, we ask that you proceed with extreme caution. Cases of Coronavirus are rising in many parts of the country. Although Lancaster county reported a few days last week where the number of new cases each day was under 30, the past three days have been 77, 46 and 60 respectively.

Blue Phase

On the Landis Homes Campus we remain in the **Blue Phase**. A chart was placed in all Residential Living mailboxes this morning to provide details. It is also posted with this update on the Landis Homes website for general reference.

Confirmed Cases & Testing

The results of the June 18 and 19 universal testing in Healthcare are not fully in. Resident tests are back with one new positive added to the three reported earlier this week. One additional positive asymptomatic team member was also identified, bringing that total to two. A few team member tests are pending.

One symptomatic team member in Personal Care has tested positive.

Universal testing this week includes 194 team members who were tested yesterday along with Personal Care residents and a small group of Healthcare residents who are being tested today.

Infection Control Survey

The PA Department of Health was on campus Monday for an infection control survey. All skilled nursing facilities will have this survey conducted before the end of July. We are happy to report that no deficiencies were identified.

Personal Care and Healthcare Visits

Window visits have been taking place for residents in Personal Care and Healthcare when able to do so safely under the current guidelines.

While engaging in window visits, please:

- Do not open windows to pass items to each other. Items may be dropped off Monday – Saturday 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at the Healthcare entrance.
- Stay clear of any window vents in place to control air flow.



The regulations for Healthcare and Personal Care are changing. We anticipate outdoor face to face visits with guidelines could begin the second week of July, depending on the presence of active cases on campus. We will announce these changes as soon as possible.

Schedule Change

Beginning next week, the video and written updates will change from Monday, Wednesday and Friday to Monday and Thursday.

Healthcare and Personal Care will not operate under these phases, as they must adhere to Department of Health regulations. 	Blue Phase
Service Category	This document provides an overview of the Blue Phase only. Some elements of this phase began 6/22, the rest will take effect 6/29.
Bank	The bank has been invited to resume hours on campus but is not yet ready to do so. Weekly bus trips to the PeoplesBank will begin. See WLH for details.
Checkpoint/ Security	Checkpoint is removed. Doors remain locked as in previous phase, including Westview and Harvest View.
Contractors	Contractors allowed in occupied units. Visitor self-screening. Follow guidelines from CDC.
Dining	Take-out only. Three meals per day from the Garden Room. Bistro for lunch (Mon-Sat) or dinner (Wed-Fri). Call ahead ordering required. Delivery fee applies.
Everence	Closed until further notice. Available by phone if needed.
Groceries	General Store resumes previous operations. Bus trips to Oregon Dairy changing from two days/week to Thursdays only. Other shopping trips begin 6/29/20.
Housekeeping	External housekeeping allowed. Visitor self-screening. Follow guidelines from CDC. Return to normal operations in house.

Blue Phase

Service Category	This document provides an overview of the Blue Phase only. Some elements of this phase began 6/22, the rest will take effect 6/29.
Life Enrichment/ Wellness Activities	<p>6/22 - Pool opens for residents only. Indoor low intensity classes allowed with limited numbers wearing face coverings. Outdoor high intensity classes without face coverings. All participants must register and undergo screening. See guidelines for pool and classes. Resident led activities resume with maximum of 10 participants.</p> <p>6/29 - Some trips resume. Activity calendar for July. Identifying the capacity of indoor spaces with COVID guidelines in order to plan future activities. Stay tuned!</p>
Maintenance	Maintenance and Contractors resume to normal operations. Follow guidelines from CDC.
Pastoral	Pastors on site for visits and to deliver broadcasted messages. Spiritual programming broadcast from WB Chapel via WLH. No funerals.
PS Salon & Spa	Closed until Landis Homes Green Phase (likely to begin 7/6/2020).
Shuttle Service	Resume for Residential Living. Drivers screened. Passengers limited to one in back seat or two if from same household. All must wear face coverings.
Visitation	6/22 - Residents can visit residents indoors. 6/29 - Indoor visits with off campus guests limited to two adults and children from same household. No visitation in indoor public spaces. Conduct visitor self-screening and follow CDC guidelines. Outdoor visits preferred.
Visitor Screening	All visitors screened at self-screening stations in Crossings or Residential Living vestibule. Name badge obtained and worn.
Volunteers	Limited volunteer opportunities in Residential Living areas only.

NOTE: Catering, room and guest accommodation reservations across campus are not being taken at this time. We will announce when this is ready to resume.
