Landis Homes Update

On Friday we reported one test going out for a Personal Care resident. That has come back negative.


Universal Testing

Universal testing of Healthcare residents and team members took place Thursday and Friday of last week. Approximately 100 Healthcare residents and 250 team members were tested for COVID-19. We believed that it would uncover asymptomatic/pre-symptomatic positive results and that is proving true. Results have come in for about half of the resident tests with four positives thus far. With approximately 90% of the team member results in as of this report, three are positive. We are consulting with the PA Department of Health and conducting contact tracing. Anyone with prolonged exposure will be notified. Residents who tested positive are being moved to a COVID designated area, if this is appropriate. Team members are now on a 14-day quarantine at home. We have been using the required PPE throughout this pandemic. These test results require additional measures to be taken, including the use of full PPE (mask, goggles/face shield, gown and gloves) in Healthcare and Personal Care. Window visits that had been scheduled for Healthcare residents will only take place if the resident has a negative test result. Those awaiting results will be postponed until results are known.

Yellow Phase

Last week we outlined what it means for the Landis Homes campus to go Yellow. Please reference the June 1 and June 5 Updates and the Residential Living Reopening Plan if you have questions. We know that some residents will begin to go off campus. The hope is that this is only for essential reasons so that we all continue to stay as safe and healthy as possible. The guidelines shared for going off campus were not intended to encourage anyone to leave, but to offer ways to stay safe should you choose to go. Please utilize your Activity Log, remember the words Time, Space, People and Place and continue to follow the guidelines from the CDC – wear your face covering, maintain physical distance and take hand sanitizer with you. This is true for interacting with other residents as well. If you visit, we recommend outdoor spaces where you can maintain physical distance.

Just because the stay at home order is lifted, it does not mean the risk is gone. Please continue to stay home whenever possible.
