Landis Homes Update July 13, 2020

In the Thursday, July 9, 2020, Landis Communities Update we shared information on the travel restrictions issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Health. As stated, these restrictions required a 14-day quarantine for any resident of PA returning from one of the 15 states on the list issued July 2. In conversation with a DOH representative on Friday, July 10, we received clarification that this was not intended to be a mandate, but a strong recommendation. The wording on the Department of Health website has subsequently been changed. Four additional states were added to the list this weekend – Delaware, Iowa, Kansas and Oklahoma.

These guidelines, like many others issued since the start of the pandemic, are fluid. We anticipate that more states will be added and that further clarification may be issued this week, specifically for long-term care providers. If this happens we will further adjust our position, but the following reflects where we currently stand:

Landis Homes and Landis Communities remain committed to continuing to follow the strictest guidance from all governing agencies for the health and safety of residents, clients and team members. We are grateful for the way many have adhered to protocols over the past several months in an effort to protect themselves and each other. Individual behavior has been a key factor in bringing us to where we are today with very few serious consequences from COVID-19. Thank you for doing what is right for the benefit of all.

We can't ignore the fact that cases of the virus are exploding in various parts of the country and it is important to not let our guard down. This recommendation from the state, though not a mandate, is based on the science of what stops the spread of COVID-19. We are all familiar with the other science-based guidelines of washing hands, maintaining physical distance and wearing a face covering. These should be practiced everywhere, whether one is in Pennsylvania or traveling.

For those who choose to travel to one of the listed states, we support the recommendation of the Department of Health but recognize that the means by which one can travel and the behavior they engage in while away can hold various levels of risk. Landis Communities will provide guidance through a questionnaire designed to evaluate exposure prior to a trip and help determine mitigation upon return. Team members will work with their supervisor to complete the form. Residents may contact their social worker with questions pertaining to their travel.

Residential Living visitors will continue to be asked about travel at screening, as it is a potential risk factor. Please have a conversation with anyone visiting from a hot-spot regarding their activities the past 14 days.



Although we are weary of living life differently, it continues to be so important to make the adjustments needed for ourselves and those we care about. COVID-19 may continue for quite some time but it will not go on forever. We are grateful for your commitment to taking appropriate safety precautions wherever you are, and whatever you do, in consideration of your health and the well-being of others. Thank you for continuing to practice patience and grace and support for each other in a community of Christ-like love.

Green Phase

Changes this week include:

- **Westview Recreation Room** is now open 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. The number of residents in the room will be limited to two on each table or court. There will be no doubles play and no spectators at this time. Face coverings are to be worn at all times.
- **Dining** – After Wednesday, July 15, the Dining Call center phone x3569 will no longer be the number for takeout and delivery orders. After that date, for Garden Room takeout or deliveries, call the Garden Room directly at x3048. For Owl Hill Bistro takeout or delivery orders call x3574. The current number will be discontinued on July 22.

The reopening committee will meet Wednesday to determine next steps. The Thursday update will provide details of other upcoming changes.

Confirmed Cases & Testing

Of the three tests reported as pending on July 9, two have come back negative. One is still pending for a resident in Residential Living. To our knowledge, no new tests have gone out for symptoms.

No additional positive tests have been reported from universal testing on July 2. Results are not in from July 9.

Reminders:

- **Activity Logs** – these continue to be an important tool. A resident reminded us last week that we are all, “dependent upon the integrity of individuals” to follow the guidance that is given.
