Blue & Green Phase

Today the Landis Homes Campus begins to move from the **Blue Phase to the Green Phase**. We anticipate that this transition will take several weeks and will only continue to move forward if it can be done safely. For this week, most of the guidelines from the Blue Phase remain in place with the exception of the following:

- **Crossings Salon and Spa** – You may call the salon at extension 2695 to schedule a haircut (wash, cut and style). Face coverings will be required and no more than two residents and their Stylist will be allowed at a time. Please do not arrive early.
- **Dining** – On Wednesday, July 8, residents and team members only may come to the Garden Room and Owl Hill Bistro to order food for takeout. Many items will be packaged and ready to serve, others will be served by team members. Limited seating will also be available. Physical distance must be maintained and masks worn unless eating. Dogwood Café remains closed to residents.

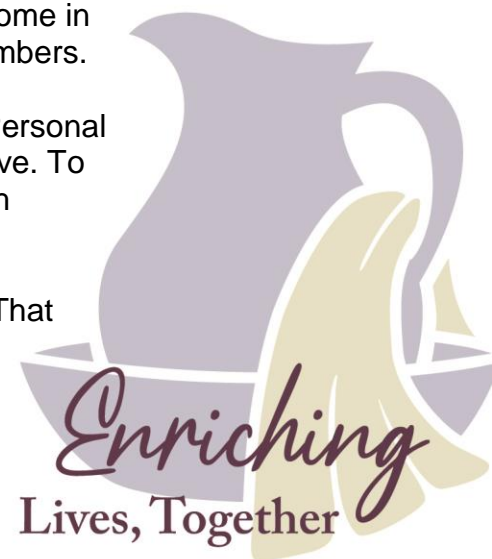
The reopening committee will meet Wednesday to determine next steps. The Thursday update will provide details of other upcoming changes.

Confirmed Cases & Testing

Most results from universal testing on June 25 and 26 are now in with no new positive cases. July 2 universal testing results are also starting to come in with no positive cases to report thus far from residents or team members.

The four pending tests reported last Thursday for Healthcare and Personal Care Residents experiencing symptoms have all come back negative. To our knowledge, no tests are currently pending for any residents with symptoms.

No new Covid-related deaths have been experienced on campus. That number remains at two.

Supplies of PPE remain good this week. We continue to order when items are available so we are prepared if new cases arise.

Personal Care and Healthcare Visits

Window visits continue for Healthcare and Personal Care Residents. The guidelines for reopening these areas include completing prerequisites and following a three-step plan. The team is working to outline this for residents and family members.
