

## Landis Homes Update August 17, 2020

We are grateful for the residents and team members who are continuing to take precautions when traveling outside of the area and particularly when leaving the state. We ask that you plan ahead by considering the things you can do to reduce your risk of exposure while in airports, in group settings and even while visiting family. These may include things like wearing a face shield along with your face covering, keeping a six foot “bubble” around you in groups and even though it may be difficult, not hugging or shaking hands.

As a reminder, Pennsylvania has a list of states where a 14-day quarantine is recommended upon return. They are currently: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee and Texas.

Of course, even if staying local, do not let our guard down. This graphic provides the latest information on cases in Lancaster County. It is important to note that the target for new confirmed cases per 100,000 over the last 14 days is 50 but we are currently at 103. It will take effort by each of us to be diligent in our actions for this number to trend downward.



### Confirmed Cases & Testing

We are not aware of any positive cases of COVID-19 or any pending resident tests at this time.

### PPE Update

Current supplies of PPE are good. We continue to order as we are able.

### Healthcare and Personal Care Reopening

- **Healthcare Reopening** is now Step 3 with scheduled in-person visits.
- **Personal Care Reopening** is in Step 1 of their plan so scheduled window visits continue. If all remain free of COVID-19, we could move to Step 2 and in-person visits could resume August 26.
