Residential Living Visitors

Updated November 9, 2021

- All visitors screened at self-screening stations in Crossings or Residential Living entrance, even if they have been vaccinated or have had COVID-19. Name badge obtained and worn while on campus.
- Visitation in resident accommodations, including overnight, at resident discretion. Guests may be in common areas unless otherwise noted. The pool and fitness center remain closed to guests.
- Follow all regulatory guidelines including wearing a face covering, practicing hand hygiene and maintaining a minimum of six feet of physical distance.
- Outside guests are allowed to dine in the Azalea Room and the Owl Hill Bistro (not the Garden Room at this time). Visitors should wear masks until seated at a table. Dogwood Café remains closed to residents and guests.
- To make a guest room reservation, or if you have any questions regarding your current reservation, call 717.569.3271, Ext. 3079, Monday-Friday, 8:00-3:30pm. You can also send an email to ReservationOvernight@landis.org.
- Residents, staff and agencies of LMC and Atlantic Coast Conference may reserve rooms on campus. Those affiliated with residents may reserve a room as long as a resident is attending the event. Request will be accepted no later than 6 months before the date of the event. For reservations, call 717.569.3271, Ext. 5246. Donations are appreciated. Not pets permitted in meeting rooms or chapels.

Personal Care Visitors

Updated January 13, 2022

- General in-person visitation is available daily from 8:00 a.m. 8:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary.
- There is a maximum of two (2) visitors per resident room, including a child of any age. Individuals age 2 and over must wear face coverings, regardless of vaccination status.
- Weekday visitors must pass screening at the Personal Care entrance between 9:00 -4:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. Evening and weekend visitors must screen at the Dogwood entrance. A visitor's vaccination status does not eliminate any of the screening requirements.
- Visitors must visit in resident rooms only. Visitors are not permitted to visit in common areas or the Dogwood Café. Outside visitation with masks is acceptable with only the two visitors that have passed screening.
- Personal Care residents who have been vaccinated may choose to have close contact with their visitor in their room.

Healthcare Visitors

Updated November 15, 2021

- All visitation is open in Healthcare.
- All visitors must enter and screen in and out at the Dogwood entrance.
- Visitors are required to follow infection control prevention strategies, including properly wearing a face covering at all time, hand hygiene, and practicing social distancing.
