Schedule

October was a busy month at the Meadows Hybrid Homes site, with major progress on both buildings. The team completed the stair towers and elevator shaft for Building #2, finished installing underground electrical and plumbing, and poured the concrete floor that will serve as the base of the building. For Building #1, crews completed the foundation, along with the elevator shaft and one of the stair towers.

As we move into November, framing work will begin on Building #2, marking an exciting step as the structure starts to take shape. Crews will also begin framing Building #1, install underground utilities, and pour the concrete floor for that building in the weeks ahead.
